The team in Malawi is translating the Bible into the language and terminology used by the local people, and printing various scripture booklets. This is really exciting work, having God's Word translated into a language it hasn't been seen in before for people who have not read it before.

This is an enormous privilege, as candidates are linked with people in Australia who will become a source of inspiration and encouragement as they commence their cross-cultural placement.

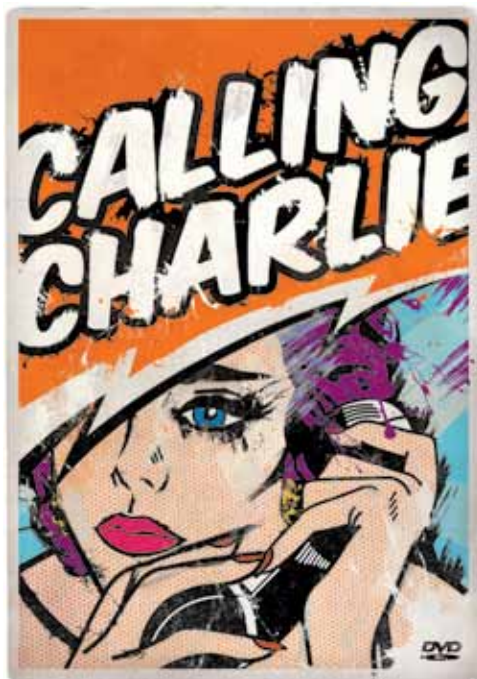
