

OCTOBER

13 T Australia: Pray for God's protection and guidance over each member of the **State Teams**. Give thanks for the essential role they play as they support the cross-cultural workers.

***14 F Mozambique:** p.7 Pray for **Scott and Rebekah** with Levi, as they prepare for cross-cultural mission. Ask for perseverance as they continue Portuguese and for people who will partner them financially and prayerfully.

***15 S Silk Road Area:** p.9 Pray for **John and Glenda**. Ask for Glenda's health to stabilise. Ask for wisdom and discernment for John as he re-builds the team and their work.

***16 S Central Asia:** p.11 Pray with **Gaye and Dan** ^ as Don's work takes a new direction. Pray for another teacher to carry on Don's work with students from very poor parts of the province.

***17 M Thailand:** p.15 Pray for **Larry and Jan**. Give thanks for their energy and work in the village. Ask that they may return from home assignment refreshed in mind and spirit.

18 T Malawi: p.7 Pray for **Steve and Glenda** as they adjust to life back in Africa and give thanks that they are providing leadership to the team. Pray that they will be fully supported financially very soon.

19 W Thailand: p.15 Pray for **Michael and Julia** as they prepare to return to Thailand. Ask God to provide them with a partnership team to support them prayerfully and financially.

***20 T Malawi:** p.7 Pray for **Wendy and Ian**, Simeon and Benjamin. Pray for Ian as he trains Yawo people to teach foreigners another language and as he finds appropriate linguistic and cultural terms to express the gospel.

***21 F Cambodia:** p.17 Pray that **Catherine** will constantly be open to God's leading and direction as she considers how she can best use her gifts for the team. Ask that she will have opportunities to share her faith.

22 S Silk Road Area: p.9 Pray for **Harvey and Nahtaw** who have returned to Silk Road Area again. May they grow in their language and cultural understanding and develop appropriate ways to respond to the needs of rural people.

SEPTEMBER

***3 S South Asia:** p.13 Pray for **Bruce and Pauline** as they support the team. Pray for the development of courses that will utilise the new Training Centre and adequate funding for the work of the centre and the other projects in South Asia.

***12 M Bangladesh:** p.27 Pray for **Geoff** as the handover of the Joyramkura hospital program proceeds and more projects are localised.

16 F Cambodia: p.17 May God give **Ron and Heather** patience as they learn the Khmer language and culture. Praise God with them for the many local people who are committed to following Jesus.

17 S Australia: Pray for the **People Group Advocates** in each state who work tirelessly to keep Baptist churches connected with the work of Global Interaction. Ask that churches will be encouraged to engage more deeply with cross-cultural mission.

18 S South East Asia: p.19 Remember **Dave and Edwina** ^ as they grow in cultural understanding. Pray that God will provide a supportive partnership team and that they will continue to make strong relationships and live out God's work.

***19 M Central Asia:** p.11 Pray for **Cliff** ^ as he deepens his understanding of and connection with local people and their beliefs. Ask that he may be supported by genuine friends and that opportunities to share his faith in our Lord may arise.

20 T Malawi: p.7 Pray for safety for **Robyn** as she travels with Mama Dave and that new teaching materials they develop will be well received.

21 W Thailand: p.15 Give thanks as **Muana and Villy** see the hand of God working in the lives of people around them. May indigenous leaders continue to develop in their comprehension and understanding of Scripture.
