“I didn’t ever think that I’d have the opportunity to return to Papua New Guinea after a 25 year gap! Lyn and I lived in PNG 1977 to 1981 as missionaries commissioned by Australian Baptists. Geoff visits PNG twice annually and does some work for the BUPNG while in Australia. He continues as a Regional Consultant with Queensland Baptists for the other 60% of his time.

- ▶ working with John Kaewa, the General Director, and others in the ministry team of the Baptist Union of PNG
- ▶ visiting Baptist church areas throughout PNG
- ▶ assisting in whatever ways the leaders of PNG determine are of help
- ▶ being a representative of continuing Australian Baptist interest in the ministry of the Lord in PNG
- ▶ being encouraged and learning, as much as encouraging and assisting others
- ▶ as consultant, providing liaison between BUPNG and Global Interaction

Geoff has been a Baptist pastor since 1970. Besides PNG, he and Lyn have ministered in three Queensland Baptist Churches. They have three children and three grandchildren. Since 1992 Geoff has had a state role with Queensland Baptists – involved with churches and pastors in matters of Church and Leaders’ Health. Geoff is an ordained Baptist minister and has a Doctorate of Ministry.

Geoff is most comfortable in equipping, encouraging and coaching, and these gifts fit well in the current BUPNG context. As one aspect of his role, he has been invited to coach some senior pastors in recording the stories of God’s working in spiritual awakening over a 30-year period.
