

Workers for the Harvest - Outback Australia

Global Interaction has been seeking to share Christ with remote Indigenous communities across the Northern Territory since the 1950's.

Currently, there are six communities in which Global Interaction ministers, alongside existing Indigenous Baptist fellowships.

The Indigenous believers in these fellowships have identified a need for leadership development and evangelism so that their remote faith communities can reach out to their own people, in their own distinctive, culturally appropriate ways.

However this training work is virtually impossible on a consistent, regular basis, with Mat and Shannon being the only workers.

The Outback team is praying that the Lord will raise up more workers for this part of the harvest because God continues to be on the move.

Shannon shares, "We recently celebrated the baptism service for two men who are new believers. They have been considering this step for a while and were able to complete a Bible study with some of the Indigenous church leaders and Mat.

The church was packed with family members from the area. There was also a baby dedication service with many families bringing little ones.

It was an exciting day and we pray that these men will continue to grow in faith, witnessing to others the transformation that Jesus brings."

Praise God for the movement of His Spirit and pray with the Outback team that more workers will be raised up for this ministry.

Outback Australia (pg 27)

- 1 S **New Believers:** Praise God for the Indigenous believers who were recently baptised. Pray that their lives will be a witness to God's transforming power.
- 2 M **Local Church:** Pray for strength for the church leaders as they pastor their communities and pray that more people will be drawn to experience Jesus for themselves.
- 3 T **Team:** For more workers to be raised up to serve in Outback Australia to support the local church leaders.
- 4 W **Vivian:** For divine insight for Vivian as he leads the Outback team and makes strategic plans.
- 5 T **Mat and Shannon:** Wisdom for Mat and Shannon as they journey with local believers and leaders.
- 6 F ***Elizabeth, Peter, Caleb and Samuel:** Ask that making new friends in community happens easily for the children as they are currently not attending the local school.

- 7 S **Opportunities:** That the people in Western Thailand have opportunities to hear about Jesus through the ministry of Jit and Jan and other local believers reaching out.
- 8 S **Jit and Jan:** Peace for Jit and Jan as they spend longer in Australia than anticipated and thank God for the technology that allows them to stay in touch with their Lanternlight team and local friends.
- 9 M **Lanternlight:** For the project team as they continue to support Thai families who live with disability and now also face the challenges of the virus.

Hong Kong (pg 28)

- 10 T **Ministry Training:** Praise God for the many thousands who have been trained to serve in Churches and outreach ministries across Asia.
- 11 W **Lindsay and Jane:** God's presence to envelop Lindsay and Jane as they conclude their ministry after decades of faithful and effective service.

India (pg 29)

- 12 T **Faith Communities:** Praise God that through intercultural mission a large network of churches now exists in Assam, India.
- 13 F **Intercultural Workers:** Thank God for the Global Interaction intercultural workers who have been sent from Mizoram, India.
- 14 S **Empowering the Adivasi Project:** Pray for financial provision for this project so that people will be able to access food, clean water, healthcare and education.
- 15 S **Scholarships:** For daily encouragement for the scholarship students so that they complete their training and are equipped to teach.

Lebanon (pg 29)

- 16 M **God's Power:** That there would be a supernatural move of God across Lebanon.
- 17 T **Milard and Joyce:** Insight for Milard and Joyce as they continue to serve the church in Lebanon through online meetings from Australia.
- 18 W ***Gabriella, Daniella and Joel:** For their experiences to shape them into compassionate followers of Jesus whose stories lead others to know Him.
- 19 T **Church and Leaders:** Strength and clarity for the Lebanese associate pastor and leaders who are stepping up in Milard and Joyce's absence.
- 20 F **Seekers:** For God to be drawing Lebanese people to Him and that more people will come to know Jesus.

Papua (pg 30)

- 21 S **God's Word:** Praise God for the distribution of Bibles in the Dani language in Papua.
- 22 S **Mark:** For insight for Country Consultant Mark as he partners with Papuan faith leaders as they respond to the diverse needs of the local people.

Papua New Guinea (pg 30)

- 23 M **Local Believers:** For protection for the local believers as they share the Gospel in villages with people who have not yet heard the message of Jesus.
- 24 T **Equipping Local Leaders:** That as pastors attend leadership training courses they will be equipped.
- 25 W **Kyaka Enga Bible:** Praise God that the Bible has been translated and distributed among the community.
- 26 T **Supporting Leaders:** Pray for generous Kingdom minded partners to financially support the Baptist Church in PNG in providing core ministry functions.

Zambia and Zimbabwe (pg 30)

- 27 F **Future Leaders:** Ask God to raise up powerful young people who will be future church leaders and overcome any barriers for them to attend training.
- 28 S **Country Consultant:** Praise God for the 50 years of faithful service of Keith. Pray for a smooth transition to David and a continued strengthening of the churches.
- 29 S **Church Leader Training:** For courage and patience for the local leaders who are learning how to teach and disciple their own people.
- 30 M **Scholarships:** Pray that these scholarships will enable leaders to access further Biblical studies and be equipped to empower faith communities to grow in influence in their communities.
